

# Maritime Resource Management (MRM)



## Target group

Maritime resource management is a training program for ship's officers, based on the knowledge and experience of the airline industry. It is designed to give members of a ship's bridge/engineer team opportunities to review and practice the skills and knowledge required to effectively utilize their human resources and equipment in order to safely and successfully operate their vessel at sea and in restricted waters.

## Admission requirements

Participants have a nautical seafaring background.

## Course content

The objective is to support a change of attitude and increased knowledge about human and technical resources in an operational maritime environment.

During the course participants will come into touch by means of discussion, theoretical lectures, computer based training and practical training on simulators with the following course subjects:

- Situation Awareness
- Cultural Awareness
- Human errors
- Communications
- Teamwork

- Decision making
- Stress management
- Procedures and unexpected events

## Course duration

3.5 days and will include theoretical lectures and simulator sessions.
